


#### Maritime Regions ...

- 'geographical stages' for marine policy regimes
- 'sets of <u>agreements</u> among a <u>defined group of actors</u> specifying:
- 1. the distribution of power and authority for the marine geographical region;
- 2. a system of rights and obligations for the members of the group;
- a body of rules and regulations that are supposed to govern the behaviour of members'
