INTRODUCTION

- Is there a geographical difference in the health of the public?
- The importance of investigating public's perception
- Ongoing research started in 2008
 - Effects of major road changes on two small rural towns in northern Iceland
 - Several research aspects e.g. employment, real estate market, social life and health

HEALTH CARE SERVICE IN PLACE- 2009

<u>Ólafsfjörður:</u> (850 inhabitants)

- Primary health care
- Nursing care home

Siglufjörður: (1277 inhabitants)

- Primary health care
- Nursing care home
- Hospital with emergency unit

AIM AND RESEARCH QUESTIONS

 How satisfied are the inhabitants of Siglufjörður and Ólafsfjörður with the health care service in place, the access to it, and the variety and quality of it, before major road changes?

METHOD


- Household survey conducted in November and December 2009
- Questionnaire
- 732 completed the survey
 - 53% of all inhabitants of the two towns, aged 18 and older
- Two questions about health care service
- Descriptive statistics
 - Statistical tests, chi-square, used to compare variables


RESULT: SATISFACTION WITH HEALTH CARE SERVICE

RESULT: SATISFACTION WITH ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE SERVICE









DISCUSSION

- The public was overall satisfied with the health care service
 - Less satisfied with variety and quality of it
- Differences in age, gender and place of living
 - Inhabitants of Siglufjörður are more satisfied
 - Women slightly more satisfied
 - Older people are more satisfied
- Satisfaction linked to local health care service
- Needs to be investigated further using other research methods
