

Shrinking regions




- Regions lagging behind in what senses?


















Handbook on demographic challenges



Demographic vulnerabilities


- 10 different demographic parameters










Kalmar








Challenges


- Kalmar county as a whole is vulnerable on 5 of 10 indicators
- 4 out of 12 municipalities are vulnerable on 9-10 indicators
- Kalmar municipality differs from the other municipalities (vulnerable on 2 of 10 indicators (65+ above the treshold and 0-14 below treshold)
- Low commuting to and from adjacent regions due to lacking or poor communications
- Economy based on SMEs with low productivity








Norrbotten







Challenges

- 10 out of 15 municipalities in Norrbotten are vulnerable on 9 or 10 parameters
- Challenges when it comes to provision of labour force and competence, provision of welfare service etc.
- General initiatives to secure provision of competence and generation shift: regional platforms to analyze the need for provision of competence.
- The mining boom?
