The 2nd NRF - call for participation

The second NRF will take place in Great Novgorod, Northwest Russia, from the 18th to the 21st of September in the year 2002. The Northern Research Forum of Russia (NRFR, *Severnyi Issledovatel'skii Forum Rossii*) will aid the NRF Steering Committee and Secretariat in organizing the second Forum.

The NRF Steering Committee announces a following tentative list of possible themes and topics for the second Forum. The precise choice of themes and sub-themes for the plenary sessions, as well as workshop items and topics to be included during a „day of projects“ within the Forum, will be tentatively open for a general discussion for some time. Please send your ideas and comments as to contents for the second Forum to the NRF Secretariat (nrf@unak.is), Lassi Heininen, Chairman of the NRF Steering Committee (lassi.heininen@urova.fi), Andrei Golovnev, for the Northern Research Forum of Russia (golovnev@basko.ru), or any member of the NRF Steering Committee (see „The Mission and Activities of the NRF,“ this volume).

When holding its fifth meeting in Great Novgorod, on November 1-3, 2001, the NRF Steering Committee will make further decisions as to the themes, topics and structure of the second NRF. Furthermore, upon this meeting, calls will be made for soliciting special agenda or background papers, 2 to 3 for each theme session, from individuals in different fields, widely

distributed throughout the northern region. These brief essays will be published and disseminated by June 2002, as they are meant to serve as a spring-board inspiring discussions during the second Forum in Russia.

Potential themes for the second NRF in Great Novgorod, 2002 - a tentative list:

- (1) Relevance of history.
Vikings and Novgorodians; historical meeting places of cultural influences of east and west.
- (2) Traditional knowledge and the applications of new technology in the North.
Emphasis on people & environment at risk. Case studies dealing with, for example, co-management regimes, entrepreneurship, telemedicine and communication, climate-change impacts on northern societies and cultures.
- (3) Alternative and renewable energy sources.
For example, case studies dealing with “winners and losers,” especially the human and social consequences of oil and gas drilling; the improvement of energy efficiency; and the energy systems of the Baltic Sea region.
- (4) Society, science and politics - in theory and in praxis.

- Includes, the venues of Arctic Science, in Russia particularly; the rebirth and reconstruction of a research community in Russia.
- (5) Protected areas and natural parks.
For example, case studies dealing with the Solovetskije and Vrangelya islands.
- (6) Population dynamics and policy.
Population movements; booms and busts; employment and human capital, quantity and quality thereof.
- (7) Higher education in the North, especially in the context of the developing University of the Arctic.
- Emphasis placed on the role and participation of Russia as well as indigenous peoples in University of the Arctic programs and initiatives.
- (8) Implementation of Northern Dimension / Northern Dimension as a multi-faced concept.
Includes, case studies dealing with e.g. the Euro-gio Karelia; the Baltic-Nordic dimension.
- (9) New political visions, innovations and structures, and security arrangements in the North.
The 'Polity Puzzle' of the North, including case studies dealing with e.g. governance and self-determination and different concepts of security.
