The 3rd NRF Open Meeting: The Resilient North - Human Responses to Global Change

A Call for Participation

The third NRF Open Meeting will take place in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories, Canada, from the 15th to the 18th of September in the year 2004. The event will be hosted by the Government of Northwest Territories, the City of Yellowknife and Aurora College, and organized by the Northern Research Forum in cooperation with the Canadian Polar Commission.

During its 9th meeting in Yellowknife, on October 30th to November 1st 2003, the NRF Steering Committee will make further decisions as to the structure and special topics of the third Open Meeting. Subsequently, the Committee will solicit special position papers, 2 to 3 for each theme session, to be written specifically for the event by individuals prominent in Northern issues from a variety of backgrounds. These brief background and agenda essays will be published and disseminated in the summer of 2004, as they are meant to serve as a springboard inspiring discussions during the third NRF Open Meeting in Canada.

The NRF Steering Committee hereby announces a following list of thematic plenary sessions, with subthemes, and project sessions for the third Open Meeting. The precise choice of sub-themes for the plenary sessions, as well as workshop topics to be included during a "Day of Projects," will be tenta-

tively open for a general discussion for some time. The Resilient North

- Human Responses to Global Change

The circumpolar north has always been a region of dramatic changes to its environment both during and between periods of human occupancy. People of the North have an inherent ability to adapt to change, whether it is rapid or gradual, and their cultures, societies and economies have responded with a vibrancy that is greater than many other regions of the world.

In the last two centuries the North has seen periods of political influence from the south and now, as it moves to strong local and regional political systems, is approaching the opportunities and challenges of globalization in innovative ways. The main theme of the 3rd Open Meeting of the Northern Research Forum, "The Resilient North - human responses to global change," builds on the themes of the Akureyri and Veliky Novgorod Open Meetings, "North Meets North" and "Northern Veche", with a focus on those issues that are challenging the ability of northerners to adapt to change. The causes of change have usually been outside the region and beyond the control of the population, and therefore, leadership is critical in the North.

The Plenary and Project Day sessions of the 3rd NRF Open Meeting will demonstrate some of the responses to the opportunities posed by globalization, climate change and other global changes, while broadly addressing questions of security and how to implement and promote adaptive capacity and human change in the North.

Plenary 1

Perspectives of Appointed and Elected Officials

The North is represented in regional, national and international debate by appointed officials and elected leaders from all levels of government and from within communities. We are requesting that officials provide their own unique experiences in general to the current relationships of North to South and North to North, and to the themes of the Open Meeting.

Plenary 2

Governance, Resources and Co-management

Governance in some parts of the Arctic has changed dramatically and is in the process of change in most other parts. The people of the North are asserting greater national and international roles while responding to globalization of economies, to international agreements that marginalize the north, and to the effects of climate change. The second plenary session will provide a wide range of perspectives on how an inherent resilience of the North may serve to

ensure that the North seizes the opportunities being presented in the 21st century.

Possible topics for discussion include:

- Building capacity for long term economic growth
- Efficient use of energy resources and development of alternate technologies
- Scenarios for culturally and environmentally sensitive resource exploitation
- · Ensuring local investment in the economy
- Methodologies to ensure removal and cleanup after economic activity
- Equity and Inheritance. The maintenance of the value of resources in the North with a significant proportion of value added during manufacture and processing
- · The role of media in government
- · ICT and emerging models of governance

Plenary 3

Cultural Resilience and the Tourist Economy

Tourism and its associated services are viewed in many parts of the world as a significant part of the economic advancement strategy. Tourism focusing on culture raises serious issues for dynamic societies as it is often rooted in the past and addresses history in a stereotypical manner. Tourism focusing on environment, either positively, such as eco-tourism, or actively, such as hunting, raises ethical and conservation issues. This theme has a field trip component to Rae Edzo, a Dogrib First Nation community, where we will discuss research issues such as the resilience of the local population, and the role of tourism as a mainstay of the economy.

Possible topics for discussion include:

- The sustainability of initiatives based on environments where global warming in the overall climate change scenario is having its greatest effect
- How cultures address tourism where heritage and relevance of history are controversial issues
- The source of investment capital for large-scale

- activities in regions of low population density
- Questions of indigenous communities' relationships to national legislation on, for example, guiding and accreditation for tourist facilities, firearms, and licensing of infrastructure
- Time conflicts between tourism activities and land-based cultural activities

ranged from circumpolar research initiatives such as Reindeer / Caribou programs, to assessment initiatives such as the Arctic Human Development Report, to organizations such as the University of the Arctic. In Yellowknife we wish to illustrate a number of initiatives reflecting resilience and human change, not just in the circumpolar world, which may have important messages elsewhere in global society.

Plenary 4

Security

Possibly transcending all issues in the North is the wide ranging one of concepts of security. Security involves all elements of resilience of northern communities. It ranges from notions of military security and the nation state, which many consider to be outdated, to environmental security, and to the most pressing concepts of civil security. Civil security involves culture, food and freedom of expression; the security afforded by the built environment and community health; the access to the needs of modern societies without the intrusion of aspects of southern society; and security of communications.

The plenary session could consider themes of:

- Militarization both de-militarization and remilitarization of the North
- Security through new governance structures emerging or already in place in the North
- The ability to respond to environmental or human disasters
- Civil security in a world of media globalization of culture
- The meaning of the national borders in a circumpolar world
- Culturally relevant education
- Adaptation and vulnerability in the context of global change

The NRF Steering Committee suggested the following topics. This is not a definitive list; it will be open for suggestions until February 29, 2004.
